MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION OPTIONS

Registration for the 2023 season has begun. There are 2 ways to register:

- Go to Dunmooretennisclub.com. Follow the steps to complete and submit the
 registration form and pay using PayPal. You will automatically receive an email
 confirmation with the gate code and the code for the lights. Please email
 memberships.dunmooretennisclub@gmail.com if you have not received an email within 24
 hours of registering.
- Print, complete and mail or deliver the registration form to: Dunmoore Membership, 942 Duncannon Drive, Pickering, Ontario, L1X 2P3 along with a cheque for the appropriate amount. You will receive an email with the gate code from the membership director once your registration has been processed.

Family Membership: Fee is \$80 per family. A family membership is for 1 or 2 parents and their children who are 17 or under. Anyone who does not fit into these categories will either register as an *adult single* or *junior single* member as set out below.

Single Membership:

Junior: (17 & under) is \$15—parent or guardian must sign the application form.

Adult: is \$50.

Junior vs. Adult: We only have two age divisions at Dunmoore, **Junior** (those 17 years and under) and **Adult** (18 years and over) as of May 1st of the current year.

ENTRY TO THE CLUB

There is a combination for push button gate access which will be provided to you upon registration. This number may be changed during the season and you will be notified by email. Please do not disclose the combination number to nonmembers or guests. Please ensure the gate is locked if you are the last one to leave.

INTRAMURAL LEAGUES

Tuesday Competitive House League

The season starts in May and runs to September. This competitive league gives our more experienced players an opportunity to play at a competitive level against other Dunmoore players. Membership in a DRCTL Dunmoore A, B or C team is not a prerequisite, but to play in the Tuesday Competitive House League, you must be of a C+ level or higher caliber. You may be required to attend tryouts to play in this league. The league will utilize all 4 courts with games scheduled at 7:00 and 8:30 p.m. Play includes men's, ladies' and mixed



doubles. Scores are tracked on an individual basis—there are no team results. Each match will consist of 3 regular sets played during the 90 minutes. If you are not available for weekly games you may join the "spares" list. Cost is \$20.00 for the season and will include balls. Thursday House League



Play will start early May and continue into September. Your matches will be 90 minutes long and will be at pre-scheduled times starting at 7:00 or 8:30 p.m. We have room for 32 beginner to intermediate players. LEVELS OF PLAY—WHAT'S YOURS?

- A. Player has consistent, strong ground strokes from both sides. Can regularly hit winners or force errors. Player can successfully execute lobs, drop shots, half volleys and overhead smashes. Player has powerful first serve with consistent second serve.
- B. Player has dependable strokes on both backhand and forehand with power. Player has ability to lob, hit approach shots and volley. Teamwork in doubles is evident. Has power with first serve.
- C. Player can consistently hit medium paced shots. Player lacks some directional and power control. Some knowledge of

- teamwork in doubles. Moderate level of net play.
- D. Just starting to play tennis. Familiar with the basic positions for single and doubles play. Can sustain short rallies with players of same ability.
